

Region of Peel Capacity Fund

Overview

The Region of Peel is issuing new funding to non-profit organizations. A Community Information Session was held to share details of the program review, program revisions, and new application cycle deadlines.

Formerly known as Organizational Effectiveness funding, the Capacity Fund aims to strengthen internal structures and improve an organization's ability to address social issues.

The fund opens once per year and offers a maximum of \$60,000 to organizations which align closely with Human Services outcomes (see next page for Term of Council Priorities).

Funding available

Up to \$60,000

Focus Areas

Our grant application should align to one of these 2 capacity focus areas:

1. Adaptive capacity
2. Financial capacity

How to apply

Once a year you will need to complete an organization profile with all supporting documents. [Complete an organization profile \(PDF\)](#).

Then, an application will be obtained from the Region of Peel.

Evaluation

Application will be based on your ability to develop an objective, measure it, and deliver results based on your work plan. For example, to increase your financial capacity, you may hire DoGood Fundraising solutions to develop a fundraising strategy, or you may engage in policy development or a policy refresh.
